Beach20 Rules

- Each game lasts a maximum of 20 balls per team or until the batting team is out
- Competitions are six-a-side
- The last batsman in can continue batting on their own until they are out or until 20 balls have been bowled
- Everyone on the fielding team except the wicket keeper must bowl four balls.
- All the bowling is from one end
- You can't be out LBW
- Wides and no balls score 3 runs with no extra ball except when the last bowler is bowling.
- It is a no ball if a full toss goes above waist height
- If scores are tied the game is to be decided by least wickets lost. If still tied then 5 players will bowl 1 ball each at the stumps and the most wickets will win.

Apart from the rules above the normal rules of cricket apply!
