



Divisions 2013

The League Management Committee has finally confirmed the divisions for 2013, the recent very wet weather having delayed a ground inspection until 4th January. Three former Tamar League clubs have been admitted to Division 7 East – Milton Abbot; St Stephens (Saltash) and Werrington Exiles. Additionally the LMC Executive has approved a request from Gunnislake CC to be relegated two divisions instead of one (from Division 5E to Division 7E) due to player strength. As a result Ladock seconds have now been additionally promoted from Division 7E to Division 6E.

Division 7 East now has ten teams and will be fixtured using the Premier League & Cup matrix, which will give four extra 'third' games against local opponents, giving a full 22 game season. The revised divisions list has been appended to this newsletter. Division 7 West has only 9 teams unfortunately so will have 16 home & away plus two additional games giving an 18 game season. Fixtures should be released no later than the weekend of 12/13 January.

AGM

Scorers

In response to the interest expressed by scorers in the South-West regarding scoring courses, the Regional Scoring Officer, Lesley Morgan, has proposed the following dates and locations. Unfortunately due to the fact that only a couple of Cornish scorers registered any interest in these courses, we are unable to run any courses within Cornwall. However there are opportunities to undertake these courses within the South-West region.

Level 2 course	Bath Cricket Club (<i>definite venue & date</i>) 24th February 2013
TCS (Total Cricket Scorer)	Bristol area – 9th or 10th February 2013
Linear & D/L (Duckworth Lewis)	Bristol area - 9th March 2013

Costs of the courses should be as follows but this could change if we have to pay for venues and have additional costs.

Level 2 course	£100 – 1 day course but this includes the candidates assessment during 2013 season
TCS	£100 – 1 day course; this will be reduced to £50 if the candidates already has the TCS current program on their computer
Linear	£50 – this is a ½ day course
Duckworth Lewis	£50 – this is a ½ day course

"The LMC is keen to encourage our scorers at all levels to obtain a recognised ECB scoring qualification. Scorers are an integral part of the game and, with the advent of electronic scoring, including the opportunity to score "live"; Higher Tier scorers especially should be considering obtaining the Level 2 standard. If the majority of scorers in the Premier and County 1 were qualified and using live score systems, that work would be supported by ECB in the form of performance payments - at the moment, Cornwall is missing out on that funding opportunity."

Sports Clubs Bank Scam

It has been brought to attention that a scam is currently in operation affecting sports clubs and club treasurers are **urged to be vigilant**, particularly in this 'downtime' of the cricket year. A leading Cornish club recently suffered when three fraud cheques, each for £890, were cashed by their bank on the same day, emptying the current account of £2,670. Luckily the club treasurer spotted it when a legitimate cheque bounced and contacted the bank immediately. The bank seemed to be well aware of the 'scam' and thankfully reimbursed the club's funds. All clubs are advised to keep a very close eye on their bank statements. Be warned!
