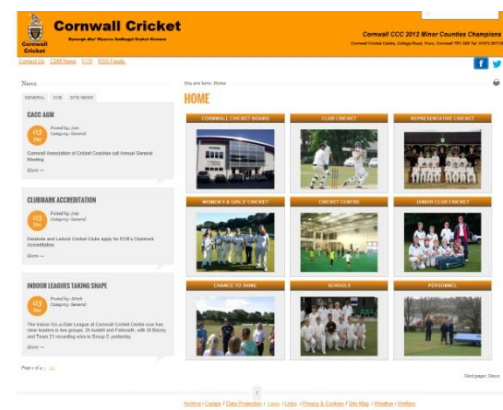

## New Website

A reminder the new Cornwall Cricket Website went live on 1st December 2012. It has the new domain of **[www.cornwallcricket.co.uk](http://www.cornwallcricket.co.uk)**

Visitors to the old site are currently being redirected automatically - but this will end in early March. You are advised to change your bookmarks **now** before the screen goes blank! New visitors to the site are advised to start with the 'News' section on the left hand side of the home, and all parent pages.

Under the CCB Tab the 'Welcome' story gives detail on how the new site has evolved. Under the 'Site News' tab there is a navigation story which will help you find your way around the site. If you still have problems remember to use the search box at the top, or Site Map link at the foot.

**Player Transfers** – Before the League accepts any completed transfer form the player **MUST** be nominated by the importing club as a PLAYER TRANSFER on their play-cricket site. The Cornwall Cricket Website has a detailed Registration help and information section plus Transfer Forms can be downloaded at Club Cricket – Cornwall Cricket League - Downloads.

### **Re-arranged Fixtures**

All clubs are reminded of the new rule that states all games that need to be rearranged due to ground unavailability **MUST** be mutually agreed by the two clubs and notified to the League Secretary no later than **Friday 1st March**. Any rearrangements after this date will have to be approved by the League first or the match will be void!
